The Fast and Prayer of "Passover"

Beginning Monday, August 17- Wednesday, September 9 (21 days, NO SUNDAYS unless desired), we will follow an Absolute Fast from 6 a.m. until 6 p.m. YOU MAY DRINK WATER AT ANYTIME. We will NOT enjoy leaven at any time from August 17- September 9, not even on Sunday. Fast will end on Wednesday, September 9 at 6 p.m.

Common Foods with Leaven

These typically contain yeast, sourdough starter, baking powder, baking soda, or another leavening agent:

- Sandwich bread
- Rolls and buns
- Bagels
- Pizza crust
- Hamburger and hot dog buns
- Croissants
- Biscuits
- Dinner rolls
- Donuts
- Cinnamon rolls
- Pretzels
- Most cakes
- Muffins
- Cupcakes
- Pancakes
- Waffles
- Quick breads (banana bread, zucchini bread)
- Many crackers
- Soft tortillas made with baking powder (some varieties)
- Breadsticks
- Focaccia
- Brioche

- Foods made from wheat, barley, rye, oats, or spelt that have fermented after coming into contact with water.

Blue:

Symbolism: Blue represents heaven and the divine connection. It is often seen in reflecting the spiritual aspect of Passover. The color symbolizes hope and renewal, aligning with the themes of liberation and redemption central to the Passover narrative.

Red:

Symbolism: Red is a reminder of the blood of the Passover lamb, which was marked on the doorposts of the Israelites to protect them during the tenth plague in Egypt.

This color symbolizes sacrifice, redemption, and the suffering endured by the Israelites, serving as a reminder of their liberation.

White:

Symbolism: White signifies purity, cleanliness, and new beginnings. During Passover, Jewish households engage in a thorough cleaning process to remove leavened bread (chametz), symbolizing the removal of spiritual impurities. White tablecloths and garments worn during represent the desire for spiritual renewal and the purity of the occasion.

Prayer and Fasting Schedule

Matthew 6:16-18 (KJV)

Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

[17] But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face;

[18] That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.

Instructions: The fast begins **6 a.m., Monday, August 17th** thru **Wednesday, September 9th at 6 p.m.** **Absolute Fast: Monday thru Friday, from 6 a.m. until 6 p.m. daily.** **We will not fast on Sundays unless you are led too.**

We may drink water at any time. Water is our only beverage.

We will not consume foods that contain Leaven. Please view the list above.

NOTE: *If you are on prescribed medications, please continue to take them as directed by your physician.*

▪ **Scripture Reading:**

- Pray for Repentance - Leviticus 26:21, 27-28,40, 2 Chron. 7:14, I John 1:9, Psalm 24:1-6 Position that God can hear us
- Pray for Insight- 'eye hath not seen' I Cor 2:9, Jer 29:11, (For I know the plans I have for you) see as God sees.
- Pray for Hindsight - Romans 8:28- And we know that all things work together for the good- (Isaiah 43:18) "Remember not the former things" nor consider the things of old. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?
- Pray- according to God's will. Trusting in God's authority and doing what he wants (even when it's different from what we want) that we align our prayers with God's will

- Seek God's Guidance - Acts 13:2-3
- The Passover Story - Exodus 12; John 1:29; I Peter 1:18-19
